As always, we will be holding the SASS Scholarship Challenge, which will be open Thursday for those wishing to compete. There is a \$5 charge each time you shoot and the proceeds go to the SASS Scholarship Fund. Cowboy Trap and Skeet return on Friday between the hours of 6:00 – 8:00pm at the clubhouse. There is a nominal charge each time you test your skills in this event.

Two meals are provided to the shooter. For any non-shooter, the fee is \$8 each for the Friday dinner and \$25 each for the Saturday banquet. Friday's dinner is held at the clubhouse.
